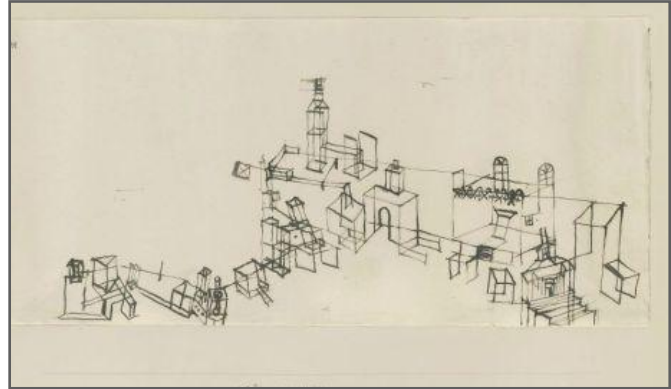
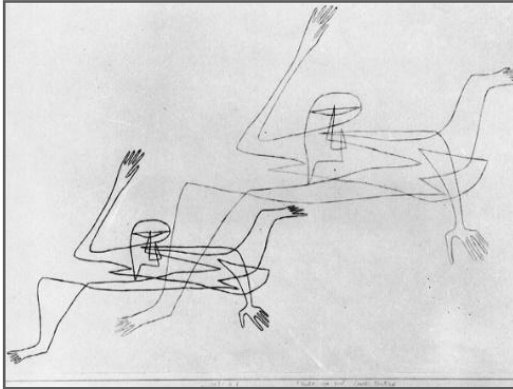


Taking a Line for a Walk



Essential Question: How do artists use line to create a composition?

Duration:

20 minutes

Art History/Inspiration:

Paul Klee artwork

Materials:

Drawing paper

Pencil

Colored pencils

Markers

Lesson:

Use Paul Klee's quote, "Drawing is taking a line for a walk", to make a drawing that starts from one end of the paper and slowly and deliberately makes its way across the page, featuring as many line styles as possible: organic; geometric; broken; and whatever reflects your mood in the moment. Let the drawing be a mindful map of where you are emotionally. Your drawing can be representational and look like something recognizable, and/or abstract, or non-objective.
